Pending a revision to the Cell Block/Prisoner Property General Order, the following procedures shall be adhered to:

Any sworn or non-sworn member of the Providence Police Department working in the Cell Block, to include Matrons and Juvenile Holding, shall place prisoner property in "Trap Bags" in accordance with departmental policy. The "Trap Bag" shall then be placed either in a locked file cabinet where applicable, or in the locker assigned to the prisoner and secured. Members shall only access this property for the purposes of seizing items or releasing property to the prisoner upon release or transport to court. Access to this property shall continue to be documented in the prisoner lock up sheet in accordance with all previous General Orders.
